



REGULATIONS FOR THE 2026 24H ROLLERS DU MANS RIDE

WHO?

The 24H ROLLERS DU MANS RIDE is organised by the Sarthe departmental roller skating and skateboarding committee (CDRS72), in association with the 24H ROLLERS DU MANS organisers and the French roller skating and skateboarding federation (FFRS).

It is open to both male and female skaters on rollerblades or longboards, with or without a licence, whether or not they are taking part in the 24H ROLLERS DU MANS, as well as to people with disabilities who are able to cover 20 km on the road.

Minors aged between 14 and 18 must have parental authorisation (on plain paper, to be carried with you).

Minors under the age of 14 must be accompanied by a responsible adult.

WHEN?

This ride will take place on Friday 10 July 2026 from 8pm to 10pm.

A compulsory briefing will be held at 7.45pm to provide information about the route and the safety rules to be observed. It does not replace the Saturday morning parade taking place on the Bugatti circuit.

WHERE?

The start and finish are in the 24H ROLLERS DU MANS village.

Access: pedestrian entrance via Piazza Luigi Chinetti (north gate).

Vehicles can be parked in the adjoining public car park.

HOW?

This is a GREEN level ride of up to 20 km.

The pace will be moderate, but the route will require you to **be sufficiently technically proficient to be able to ride independently**, as it includes a number of descents and passages over speed bumps.

SAFETY



- **Protective gear is strongly recommended** at all levels, with priority given to head, wrists, knees and elbows.

The route will remain open to traffic in its entirety, and **skaters will have to comply strictly with the instructions of those in charge**. The organisers may exclude a skater if his or her level is unsuitable or if the instructions given are not followed.

- Everyone must **bring a receptacle** (flask, cup, bottle) to quench their thirst and, if necessary, be able to obtain supplies from the organisers en route.
- The organisers have taken out civil liability insurance for all skaters and unlicensed volunteers.
- In the event force majeure, bad weather or any other circumstance likely to endanger the safety of participants, the organisers will cancel the ride.
